<b>NASHVILLE</b> Holiday Inn Express & Suites 5566 Franklin Pike Circle Brentwood, TN 37027 (615) 221-5001	<b>X-RAY</b> (Medical and Osteopathic)  To obtain a limited x-ray license in Tennessee, one must: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. be 18 years of age or older and possess a high school or GED diploma,</li> <li>2. satisfactorily complete a state-approved course,</li> <li>3. pass the state-required ARRT Limited x-ray exam, and</li> <li>4. obtain the required number of <b>supervised</b> clinical practice hours for each body category.</li> </ol> <b>First Time Students</b> - <i>must</i> take Core along with at least one body part to receive a limited x-ray license.  <b>Upgrade Students</b> - if you are upgrading, you are <i>not</i> required to take Core again.

	<b>BONE DENSITOMETRY</b>  To obtain a license to operate Bone Densitometry (BD) equipment in Tennessee, one must: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. be 18 years of age and have a high school or GED diploma,</li> <li>2. satisfactorily complete a state-approved 24-hour Bone Densitometry course,</li> <li>3. receive machine training from the manufacturer (or authorized representative) <i>or</i> by a person holding a TN license in Bone Densitometry who has received machine-specific training by the manufacturer, and</li> <li>4. pass the ARRT Bone Densitometry Equipment Operator Exam for state licensing.</li> </ol> <b>Note:</b> ARRT Registered Technologists (RTs) who did not have a Tennessee x-ray license <i>prior to July 1, 2006</i> and who perform Bone Densitometry in a physician's office in Tennessee are required to either: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. pass the ARRT Bone Densitometry Certification Exam for RTs, or</li> <li>b. go through steps 1-4 above for a Tennessee license in Bone Densitometry.</li> </ol>
