<p><i>Go to www.radiologyeducationseminars.com for maps to any course location</i></p>	<p>X-RAY (Medical and Osteopathic)</p> <p>To obtain a limited x-ray license in Tennessee, one must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. be 18 years of age or older and possess a high school or GED diploma, 2. satisfactorily complete a state-approved course, 3. pass the state-required ARRT Limited x-ray exam, and 4. obtain the required number of supervised clinical practice hours for each body category. <p>First Time Students - <i>must</i> take Core along with at least one body part to receive a limited x-ray license.</p> <p>Upgrade Students - if you are upgrading, you are <i>not</i> required to take Core again.</p>
<p>ZOOM - RES SPRING RES Spring courses will be held virtually with ZOOM.</p>	<p>BONE DENSITOMETRY</p> <p>To obtain a license to operate Bone Densitometry (BD) equipment in Tennessee, one must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. be 18 years of age and have a high school or GED diploma, 2. satisfactorily complete a state-approved 24-hour Bone Densitometry course, 3. receive machine training from the manufacturer (or authorized representative) <i>or</i> by a person holding a TN license in Bone Densitometry who has received machine-specific training by the manufacturer, and 4. pass the ARRT Bone Densitometry Equipment Operator Exam for state licensing. <p><i>Note:</i> ARRT Registered Technologists (RTs) who did not have a Tennessee x-ray license <i>prior to July 1, 2006</i> and who perform Bone Densitometry in a physician's office in Tennessee are required to either:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. pass the ARRT Bone Densitometry Certification Exam for RTs, or b. go through steps 1-4 above for a Tennessee license in Bone Densitometry.
